Welcome to Elderwood!

We are excited to be able to welcome you here today. As we continue to deal with the COVID-19 Pandemic, below are suggested precautions to keep residents and their guests safe from possible infection. We understand that these precautions can seem burdensome, but please know that we are following best-practice procedures to avoid infection.

As you visit today, please keep the following in mind:

- Testing is not required, but it is strongly recommended that visitors receive a negative test result within 72 hours prior to their visit, or a rapid test with a negative result at the time of your visit.
- Rapid tests may be available on-site, supply availability may vary - please call our community directly to confirm.
- Please wear a mask at all times while on the grounds of our facility.
- Please maintain social distance.
- Please adhere to all instructions provided by Elderwood staff.
- If your loved one needs assistance, please alert one of our staff and they will assist.
- Please be respectful of, and avoid contact with other visitors.
- There is no smoking anywhere on the grounds of Elderwood.
- Staff will be happy to answer questions.

Visitors may be required to leave at any time if they are unwilling or unable to comply with visitation guidelines or direction from staff.
